Karen,

Here are my answers to your questions.

- 1. Once the letter of intent is signed and sent, a grant specialist will be assigned to the Town of Fremont and a contract will be written. Once we receive a letter of intent, we will work with the community to draft an agreement.
- 2. Would we have time between signing the letter of intent and sending that in, and having a grant specialist assigned to the Town, to have a referendum of electors? Yes. We would provide the Town enough time to have a referendum.



- 3. What if we sign the letter of intent and the electors vote against the Fire Hall/Community Center, can we turn the grant down before the contract agreement is signed? Yes
- 4. What would the grant actually cover? Would it cover the structure of the building and labor costs only? Would it cover a well, site work or site engineering, septic system, building engineering? It can cover the structure, labor, well and septic system.
- 5. Would the Town of Fremont need to take a loan out for the total amount of the project and then the Department of Administration, Division of Housing send the grant money based on what is actually covered by the grant? The Division of Housing will not provide all the Community Development Block Grant funds up front. We will reimburse the Town as the project progresses and draw requests are made.

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
