The 4 bids for ditching were opened. After discussion Tom made a motion to accept the Goetz bid, Karen 2nd the motion. Motion Carried.

Ed is checking on the repairs to the Town Hall Entrance- bottom edge of siding and broken bench.

Dust control should be approximately the same cost as last year- .49 a foot, when roads are in shape the Town will begin dust control.
