Hereby agree and certify to the following conditions of the bid:

- The material must meet current WisDOT Standard Specification 305 Dense-Graded Base Material, with the following revised specifications. Varication required.
- Material is 100% processed (Crushed Granite), screened to a maximum of 3/4 base, and shall be well graded from coarse to fine. Sieve analysis sampled from current stockpile required before delivery. No clay binder. Supply delivered material at the above price to any location within the Town of Fremont (Clark County).
- Material shall have no additional water added. Natural occurring, unavoidable moisture is acceptable. Mechanical watering of material prior to weighing and delivery will not be allowed without written consent from Road Supervisor. Any load of bid material found to have water intentionally added without consent will either be rejected or reimbursed in full cost by the supplier to the Town.
- All material shall be delivered with a copy of a printed scale ticket for each load. Scale ticket shall include the date, time, location, truck number, tare weight, gross weight, and total yards.
- Supplier shall operate with an adequate number of delivery trucks to avoid wait time for Town patrol operator. The Town requires a delivery rate of 150 to 200 tons per hour. The town has the right to stop delivery at any time if an adequate amount of delivery trucks is not supplied.
- The town has the right to refuse any material that is not consistent with the material as bid.
- The town has the right to accept any bid, accept all bids or a combination of bids, reject any bid, reject all bids, waive any technicality in a bid, and the right to ask the supplier for clarification in a bid before award.
- A sample may be pulled from random loads for testing. Any or all trucks may be weighed at a scale located within the township.
- Loads must be delivered within ten days upon request.
- Bids will be accepted only with this form.
